

*Sail the Hudson River on  
New Jersey's official tall ship, the*  
**A.J. Meerwald**



The Tenafly Nature Center, Association of New Jersey Environmental Commissions, and the Bergen County Historical Society are co-sponsoring a series of sails on New Jersey's official tall ship, the *AJ Meerwald*, a restored 115-foot oyster schooner built in 1928. View the New York Skyline and majestic Palisades while learning about the history, environment and culture along the Hudson. This is an open deck vessel with hatch covers and wooden deck boxes for seating. Feel free to bring food and beverages (no hard liquor) but be prepared to take everything with you when you leave the craft. All sails, except the first, depart from Alpine Boat Basin, Palisades Interstate Park, Exit 2 on the Parkway. Each trip is **limited to 45 people**.
